### Always Looking Ahead



Cycling Without Age is a unique program that began as global social enterprise, Program to Encourage Active, Rewarding Lives founded in Denmark in 2012. The international organization chartered offer was to increased mobility to seniors in

the form of volunteer-piloted trishaw rides. Over the last 7 years, CWA has expanded to 40 countries, as well as to the United States. The Harvard Community Senior Center (HCSC) and Community Crosswalk (CC) have partnered to bring a Cycling Without Age chapter to McHenry County in 2020. A Steering Committee, named the Free Wheelers and made up of community members, is leading this unique program that allows volunteer cyclists to share rides on trishaws with socially isolated seniors. 50% of whom have chronic disease that limits their ability to ride independently. Isolated Seniors (or others with mobility limitations) residing in McHenry County will be taken on regular bike rides designed to:

•Improve the physical and/or emotional health status of socially isolated adults enrolled in the program over 2 years

 Create intergenerational relationships between the passengers (seniors) and their pilots (volunteers) that are mutually beneficial to both

 Integrate individuals with limited mobility back into the broader communities in which they reside

 Share positive memories of bike riding triggered by the shared rides

Provide opportunities for the Bike Riders of the McHenry county to give back, slow down, respect their elders, and improve their communities...while still getting some exercise

To help McHenry County purchase a Trishaw for our Seniors we are partnering with Crystal Lake Brewing Company to hold a fundraiser.

April 1st 5-8 p.m., Raffles, Trishaw rides, including Beer and Light Refreshments.

HCSC & CC will be at Harvard Milk days and selling Cold Stone ice cream to benefit the Trishaw purchase. Search out our table and talk to us about what you want out of your Senior Community Center. And pick up some activity flyers too!
