## Senior Health Insurance Program

Are you unsure how to apply for Medicare? Are you struggling to pay for your medications? We have inperson assistance available to help you understand the complexities behind Medicare and how to best save on your healthcare costs. The Senior Health Insurance Program (SHIP) is a free, statewide health insurance program for Medicare seniors and their caregivers. We have SHIP counselors available in McHenry County. Call the center at 815-943-2740 to schedule an appointment in-person or over the phone.
